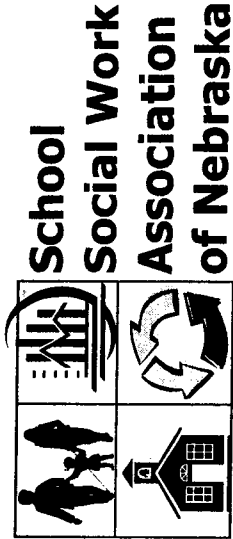

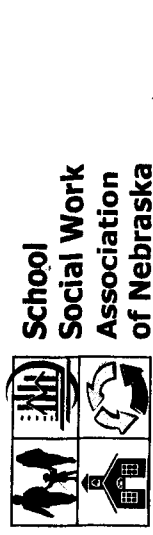

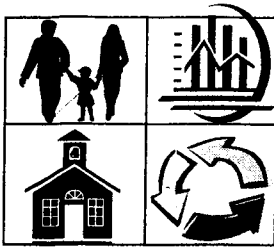

Speakers

Kelli Slagle, LMHP, therapist and supervisor of therapy services at **Choices Counseling and Consulting, Inc.**, serves a diverse population of individuals, couples and families of all ages with private insurance, Medicaid and a sliding fee scale. Ms. Slagle specializes in the use and practice of Parent Child Interaction Therapy and will be discussing effective strategies this method utilizes to engage parents in the process of parenting.

Kami Guzman, LMHP therapist and supervisor at **Choices Counseling and Consulting, Inc.**, provides therapeutic counseling to people of all ages including families and couples. Ms. Guzman's background includes experience with Volunteer CASA, after-school programming, Foster Care Review Board and Family Support Work. Ms. Guzman has received specialized training in PCIT and will describe how this modality of therapy provides for intense relationship building and compliance training for school age children.

Ronda Newman, MPA, is in her 26th year at the **Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services**. Ms. Newman has a wealth of experience in this agency at levels that include resource development, adoption, foster care, ongoing case management, abuse/neglect hotline and initial assessment. Ms. Newman is responsible for Initial Assessment for the Eastern Service Area and the Statewide Child Abuse/Neglect Hotline. Ms. Newman will present an overview of the significant changes NDHHS is undergoing by privately contracting with agencies for service coordination, and the impact this will have on families and service providers.

Susan Coffey, LMHP, a private practitioner, is a certified instructor for the Beyond Consequence Institute Parent Training Course for which the **Mother/Child Connection LLC** has seen positive effects. With 20+ years experience that includes school counseling, coaching and teaching, Ms. Coffey's practice serves individuals and families experiencing unresolved grief and trauma with an approach that is relationship-based and interactive. Ms. Coffey works with parents and children to resolve the issues that block the development of healthy, loving relationships. Her presentation, "Parenting the Traumatized Child: A Love-Based Approach to Working with Children with Reactive Behaviors" will describe interactive strategies to engage frustrated parents.
